INITIALS AND WITH THE FISHER'S ID NUMBER. BUOY LINES WILL BE WEIGHTED TO KEEP THE LINES FROM

FLOATING.

2) ALL SUBSISTENCE CATCHES SHALL BE REPORTED ON TRIBAL SUBSISTENCE CARDS. AS SPECIFIED IN TRIBAL FISHERIES ORDINANCES.

3) THE TOTAL HARVEST WILL BE NO MORE THAN 660 PER TRIBE.

ONCE THIS LIMIT IS PROJECTED TO BE REACHED THE FISHERY WILL CLOSE.
