MAY BE ANY COLOR EXCEPT YELLOW OR ANY COMBINATION OF RED AND WHITE. BUOYS MUST REMAIN FLOATING AT ALL

EXCEPT DURING EXTREME TIDES. BUOYS WILL ALSO BE

MARKED

WITH THE TRIBE'S INITIALS AND WITH THE FISHER'S ID NUMBER. BUOY LINES WILL BE WEIGHTED TO KEEP THE

LINES

FROM FLOATING.

3. THE MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR SHRIMP POTS AND RING NETS

ONE INCH, AS DEFINED IN REGULATION #S23-014.

MESH

EXCEPT FOR FLEXIBLE (WEB) MESH POTS, FOR WHICH THE

THERE

MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 1 3/4 INCH STRETCH MEASURE.

TUNNELS

IS NO MINIMUM MESH SIZE FOR ENTRY TUNNELS, BUT

CAN ONLY BE LOCATED ON THE SIDES OF THE POTS.
